Philmont Scout Ranch is the Boy Scouts of America's largest national high-adventure base. It covers 137,000 acres - about 214 square miles - of rugged mountain wilderness in the Sangre de Cristo (Blood of Christ) range of the Rocky Mountains in northern New Mexico. Philmont Scout Ranch provides an unforgettable adventure in sky-high backpacking country along hundreds of miles of rugged, rocky trails. Program features combine the best of the Old West - horseback riding, burro packing, gold panning, chuck wagon dinners, and interpretive history - with exciting challenges for today, such as rock climbing, burro racing, mountain biking, and .30-06 rifle shooting. It's an unbeatable recipe for fast-moving fun and the outdoors.

You must be at least 13 years old and completed the 8th grade by July 20th, 2012 to attend. The crew size is limited to 12, a minimum of 2, maximum of 4 adults and the balance is youth. We will be departing early on July 19th, 2012 and returning early on August 3rd, 2012. There will be several pre-hikes that will be mandatory for the crew to attend.

The cost of the trip will be approximately \$1400; a \$100 non-refundable deposit will be due at the time you sign up and another \$350 will be due September 26th, 2011 other payments dates will follow. If we have more the 12 people interested we will have a wait list in case someone has to drop out.
