How to Apply for the Honor Patrol Award

Your patrol must complete both Part One and Part Two. Have your SPL initial all requirements except for the first one, which requires your Scoutmaster's signature. This application needs to be turned by NOON on FRIDAY. Ribbons will be awarded at the awards ceremony on Friday night. One form per patrol please.

Part One: Complete all of the following requirements.

_____ Show that your patrol tries to live by the Scout Oath, Law, Motto and Slogan. (Scoutmaster or someone they choose must sign for this requirement.)

_____ Camp as a patrol in your troop site during the week and make a patrol gateway.

_____ Bring your patrol flag to all meals, campfires, overnights, hikes and other patrol or troop activities. Give your yell at appropriate times.

_____ Perform a good turn for the camp approved by one of the following people: Camp Director, Program Director, Camp Commissioner or Area Director.

_____ Have each scout in your patrol complete a merit badge, participate in the Wowoatam Program or BSA Lifeguard.

_____ Have some of your scouts participate in at least one of the following: Snorkeling, BSA Lifeguard, Mile Swim, Totem Chip, Fire M Chip, Paul Bunyan, C.O.P.E., Climb or Rappel at the Tower.

_____ Perform a skit, song, or tell a story at a troop campfire.

_____ Have every person in your patrol swimming or in the water.

_____ Have No Flame in Tent Signs on each tent in your patrol

_____ Build a pioneering project in your campsite (in addition to your gateway) using the correct knots.

_____ Participate in the Spirit of the Totem Pole Honor Program.

Honor Patrol Award

Part Two: Complete any three of the following requirements.

- _____ Cook one meal as a patrol in your campsite. Invite a staff member as your guest.
- _____ Camp as a patrol during a troop overnighter to the Primitive Village or the Tree houses. Tell a staff member about your trip when you get back.
- _____ Sleep in the open on a clear night. Identify as many constellations as you can and tell someone about them.
- _____ Take a patrol hike with a purpose, such as a nature hike, compass course, a Handicap awareness hike, or the Chippi Trail. Plan your hike in advance with your scoutmaster.
- _____ Participate as a patrol in at least three of the following activities.
 - _____ Troop swim _____ Open Boating
 - _____ Big House Tour _____ Chapel Service
 - _____ Instructional Swim _____ Story and Song Night
- _____ Visit another patrol from another troop in their campsite or invite them to come visit your site. Do something together such as swap patches, have a campfire, play games or something you come up with.
- _____ Stay in full uniform for one day during the week.
- _____ Participate in a competition with another patrol.
- _____ Talk with your scoutmaster or another adult in your troop about substance abuse.
- _____ Keep a patrol journal of your activities and thoughts about camp. Have each scout make at least one entry in it.
- _____ Complete a requirement of your own which shows that your patrol is great. Plan and have it approved by the scoutmaster before you complete it.
