## **How to Apply for the Honor Troop Award**

You must complete all of the required items plus **three** of the optional items. Requirements with a \* must be approved by the **commissioner, program specialist or program director**. Other requirements may be signed off by the scoutmaster.

### **Required Items:**

- \_\_\_\_\_ The Troop demonstrates the use of the patrol method. (Campsite arrangement, boy leadership, etc...)

- \_\_\_\_\_ Participate in the Spirit of the Totem Pole Honor Program.
