

Scouter's Merit Badge Requirements

Revised 7/24/2008

Purpose: The merit badge is designed to give adult leaders opportunities to be actively involved with camp operations during their stay. Scouters will have opportunities to visit the program areas and assist the staff, conduct service projects and generally have a good time.

Process: The program area director, camp program director, camp director, and camp commissioner may sign each requirement. After completing 9 of the 12 requirements, you have met the requirements of the badge. Take this sheet to the Camp Trading Post and you may purchase the special "Scouter's Merit Badge". The money collected for the badge (\$3.00) will go into the LLSR campership fund.

Initial: **Requirement:**

- 1 _____ Attend a leader's roundtable with the camp leadership after breakfast.
- 2 _____ Attend the camp for a minimum of one night and one day.
- 3 _____ Visit the following program areas in camp during the week. You don't have to participate in each area, but you need to visit. NOTE: Area directors may sign for these requirements.

- 6 _____ Help an area director for one block period with a merit badge or Pathfinder session.
- 7 _____ Participate in the Adult Leader Cook-off
- 8 _____ Serve on the kitchen crew for the Wednesday night barbecue
- 9 _____ Serve as an adult on an overnighter for Wilderness Survival merit badge, Wowoatam, or Pathfinders. (Worth three signatures)
- 10 _____ Serve as a driver for the Golf merit badge. (Worth two signatures)
- 11 _____ Troop participates in one of the non-advancement opportunities during your stay at camp such as: canoe trek, teepee overnight, tree houses overnight, hike Chippy Trail.
- 12 _____ Majority of troop attends Tuesday night chapel service.
- 13 _____ Troop serves as a dining hall, camp shower, Wednesday night barbecue, Friday dinner, or flag service troop during stay.
- 14 _____ Troop signs up for a site next year.
